The Tennessee Public Health Association (TPHA) was chartered in 1939 for the purpose of protecting and promoting the health of the people of Tennessee. TPHA is a 501© (6) nonprofit organization.

Vision: *Healthy People in Healthy Communities*

Mission: *To promote, articulate, and advocate for the vision of healthy people in healthy communities throughout Tennessee and the United States through an active and interested membership.*

TPHA is a statewide organization with over 1200 members representing all disciplines of public health including physicians, nurses, dentists, nutritionists, health educators, communicable disease specialists, environmentalists, administrative personnel, and management support. Membership also includes representatives from communities across the state that have special interests in the health and well being of its citizens.

TPHA
